- LAND Trust Council Membership Report
 - Continuing to pay for $\frac{3}{4}$ of a teacher's salary to help reduce class size
- Principal Assurance Form, Final Report due October 31, 2019
 - Still needs to be signed by council members
- Review UCAS data/refine SSP plan if necessary
 - Changed our literacy goal from 2% increase from BOY to MOY to 20%, which would equate to about 22 students. 2% was not lofty enough
- Review and update School Emergency Plan
 - We are working on the morning drop off procedure. We have implemented the following:
 - Drop off posters/signs at SEPs
 - Added an adult to the morning (for now) to teach appropriate procedures
 - Coned off 2nd lane so families cannot access the 2nd lane for drop off as they need to enter at the line so students can get out of the car in the 1st lane next to the curb
 - Next steps:
 - $\frac{1}{2}$ way done creating a flyer to pass out to all families to communicate the procedure
 - Create and acquire a vinyl sticker that we can pass out to families who follow the correct procedures

 - We reviewed the responsibility page and ensured we have procedures in place at the school level
- Outside air temperature
 - SIC recommended that we change it to feels like 17⁰ not actual temperature

 - Next steps:
 - Collect last years data on how many days were below 32⁰ so we can make an informed decision for a recommendation at next meeting
 - Talk about a different temperature policy for before school and lunch recess since students are often outside before school longer than lunch recess, which is 18 minutes
