- LAND Trust Budget- team agreed to use the \$53,000 towards a classroom teacher
- District FTE allocations- District FTE allocations of 15 will be assigned to: K-2 teachers, 1st Grade- 3 teachers, 2nd Grade- 2 teachers, 3rd Grade- 2 teachers, 4th Grade- 2 teachers, 5th Grade- 2 teachers, 6th Grade- 2 teachers. Additional teachers will be allocated by administration based on school budgets.
- Parent Compact- will be updated after receiving the district calendar for 2020-2021 school year.
- Policy S-10, school fees, Liberty does not charge any school fees
- School clubs, Liberty does not have any school clubs
- October 1st numbers- student population 404, 58 students transfer out, 62 students transfer in, 55% English Language Learners, 19 languages, 70.5% ethnicity (African American, Asian, Caucasian, Hispanic, Native American, Pacific Islander, and Multi), 5.2% homeless (living with other family, motel/hotel, inadequate facilities, without parent), and 100% free breakfast and lunch

- Outside air temperature for before school and at recess- committee is keeping the temperature at “feels like” 17 degrees or below is inside recess. We have implemented the “feels like” temperate change as of last November and have not had complaints from parents since.
- State Report Card- USBE Data Gateway- reviewed current data and possible changes this year since we have focused on reading and well as additional supports for teachers for next year.
- Child Access Routing Plan (Safe Walking Route/SNAP)- adding school boundary to map but no other changes are need.
- 2nd Semester EEP goals- goals remain the same as first semester
- Other: parents asked about a text option for communication such as when we have a snow day. Corner fence is not being unlocked in the morning for students to access the field and a safer walking route. Parents asked for the fence to be unlocked all the time. SIC will weigh in on this at the next meeting.
